

Motorcycle passenger safety restraints

THE Pan and Spyder belts are patented apparatuses designed to secure passengers to motorcycles where the passenger is positioned behind the rider. These devices inactivate should the rider fall from his or her machine.

Both consist of a belt attached to a large 'leaf' which the rider sits on, but differ in the restraints. Pan has a wide belt and is for urban use while Spyder is optimised for sport and touring use and has a full shoulder harness.
